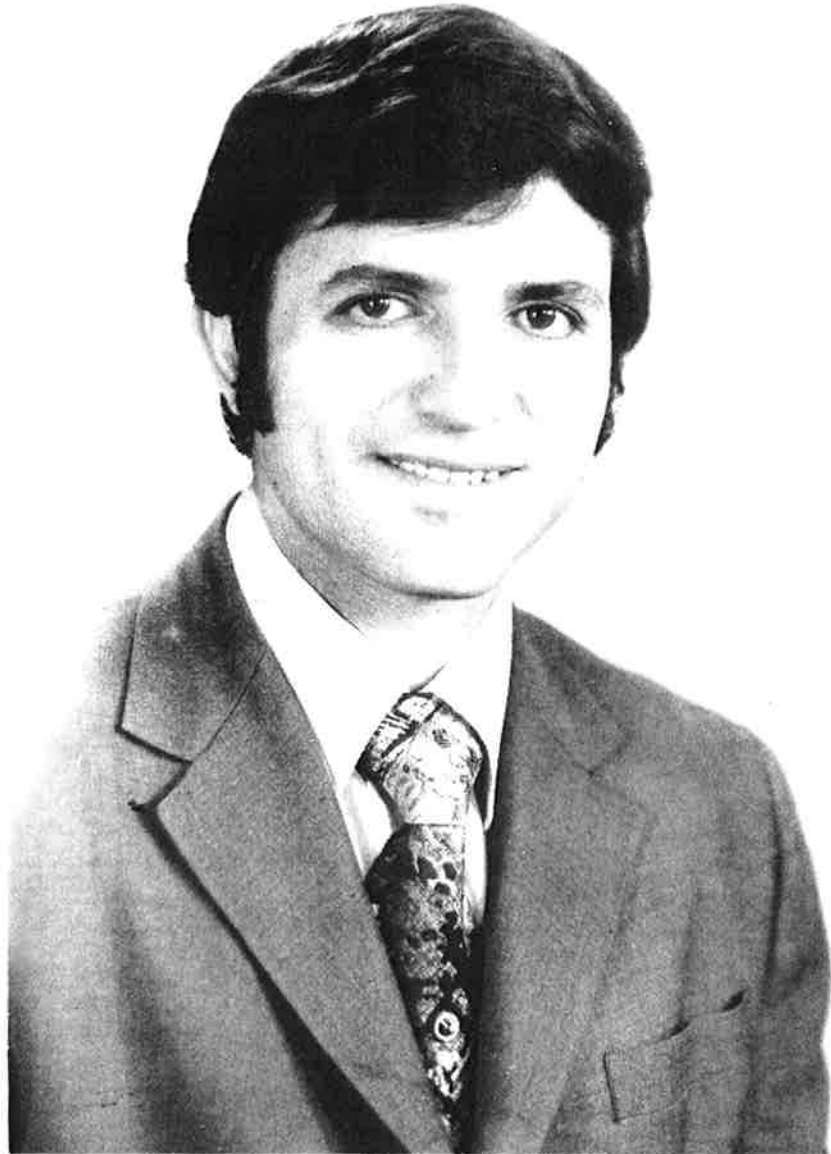

“History of Brotherhood”

It has been fifty glorious years since our forefathers saw the need to unite the Kytherian Community into the bonds of an Association, which had as objectives, good fellowship, social and cultural activities among a group of people that have a lot in common, and helping the underprivileged by contributing to various charities, both in Australia and Greece.

Early in 1921, two prominent Kytherians in Sydney brought the idea forward. It was almost 12 months before the idea finally became reality, and on the 14th of May 1922 the inaugural meeting of the Kytherian Brotherhood took place at the “Marathon” cafe situated then at No. 72 Oxford St., Darlinghurst.

That night, the founders the late Cosmas Cassimatis and Theodore Crithary, called for a constitution to be drawn up and a date to be set for a general meeting and elections of a managing committee.

The elections were held on the 20th of August 1922, and the Foundation committee was elected to serve for the following 2 years. They were:

The activity and progress of the Kytherian Brotherhood has been outstanding. The far-sighted founders of the Brotherhood, could not have possibly foreseen that the little social group they started would have grown into one of the largest Associations. Over the years, donations of many thousands of dollars have been given to various charitable institutions and associations. The activities have reached far across the oceans to the island of Kythera, where the Brotherhood has made numerous contributions to various public works, hospitals, schools and general relief to the underprivileged.

During the Second World War, the Kytherian Brotherhood was instrumental in the organisation of a war-relief fund for Greece and a large sum of money was eventually remitted to Greece.

The Kytherians of today, enjoy a very high esteem both in the Greek and Australian communities. Because of the very early migration of Kytherians to Australia, the community consists mainly of Australian born people, well established in the business and professional world.

Reflecting back over the years, it becomes very clear that the Kytherians in Australia have been among the most progressive migrants, assimilating well into the Australian community, without neglecting to carry on some of the fine traditions of the old country.

A Bit of History -

When Mr. Theo Crithary and the late Mr. Cosmas Cassimattis, pictured left, first met on the 12 May, 1921, at the "Marathon" Cafe, 72 Oxford St., Darlinghurst, little did they know that the chance meeting was to herald the forming of the Kytherian Brotherhood of Australia.

Exactly twelve months later, on the historic day of 12 May, 1922, in the presence of a number of enthusiastic Kytherians, the Brotherhood held it's first meeting with the following Foundation Office-Bearers and Members:

"Did You Know..."



On the 15th of October 1922, the Kytherian Brotherhood reserved 2 full columns in the weekly Greek Newspaper "Australia" for the sum of 20 pounds per year.

Mr. Kyriakos Frelingos was appointed General Representative of the Kytherian Brotherhood in Queensland on the 10/3/1923.

A donation for the Harbourworks at Kythera was made as far back as March 1927. The sum of 100 pounds was sent for this purpose and a further 100 for the high school.

A Kytherian was among the five investors who started the airline of Quantas, 50 years ago

An unusual project was when in 1929, the Brotherhood purchased a wooden leg for a Fellow Kytherian.

It was a Kytherian (J. D. Cominos) who introduced oyster farming in Australia.

On the 15/10/1933, the committee decided to bring out from Greece, a teacher to teach under contract for 2 years.

Women were allowed to vote for the first time on the 12/8/1934.

On the 4/10/1940, it was decided to buy a Kytherian building.

On the 19/11/1940, the above decision to buy a building was abandoned and the money was made available to be sent as War relief to War stricken Greece.

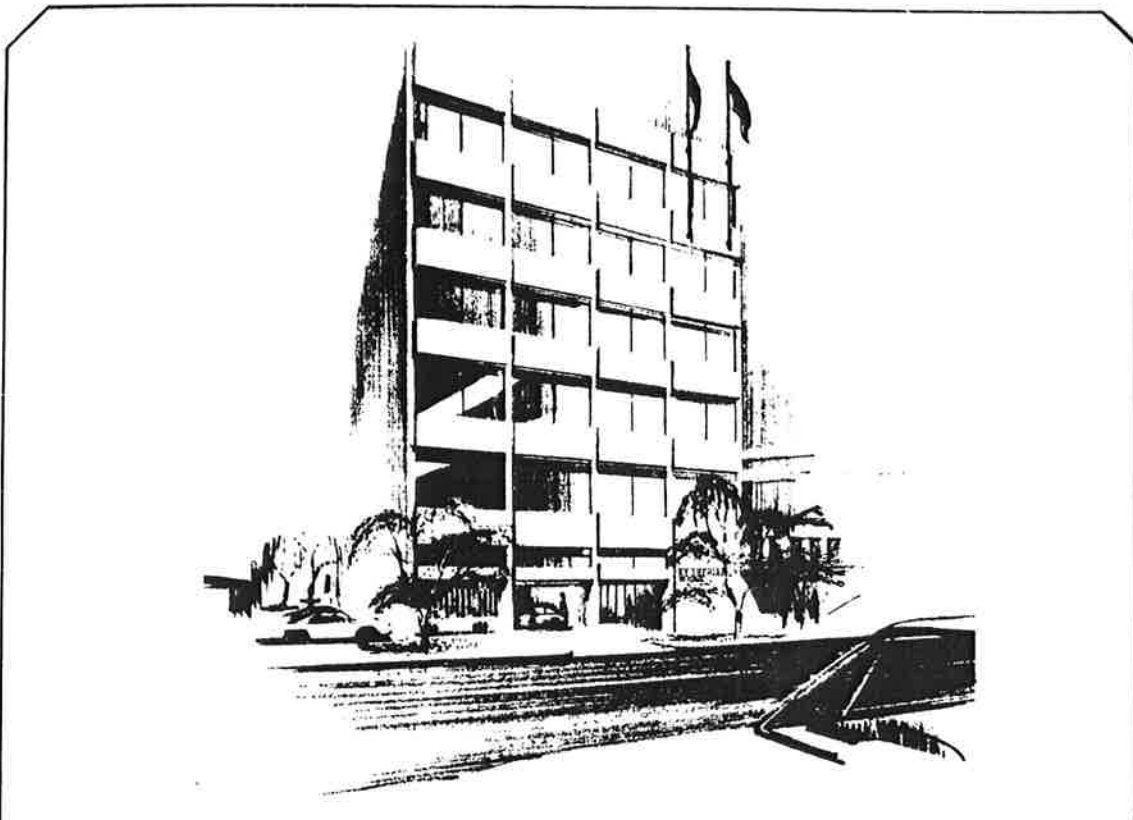
WEST FAIRFIELD SHOPPING CENTRE

94 and 96 Anzac Parade, Kensington, the two houses which stand on the sight of our Kytherian House.



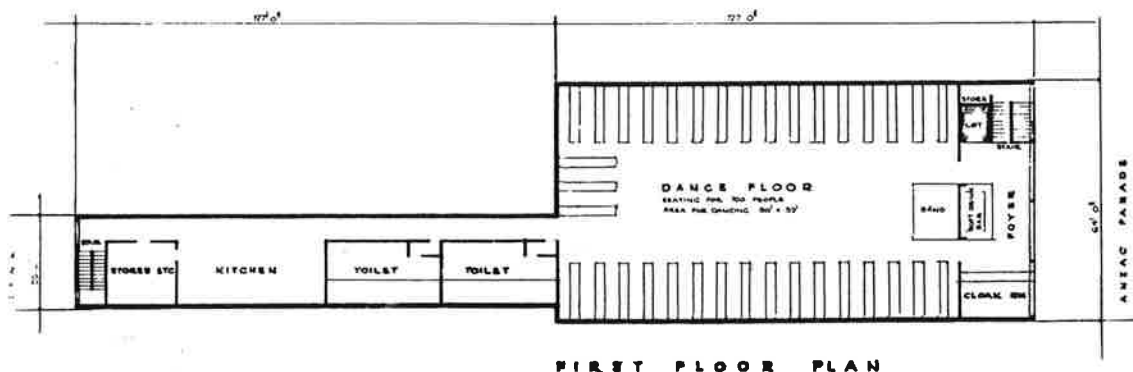

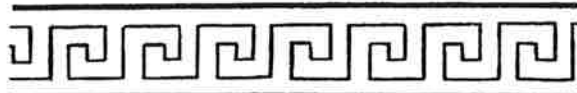

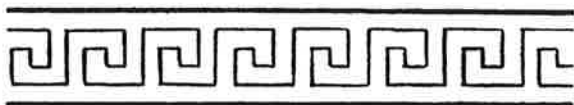

"What is an Autistic Child?"

Autism is a serious and baffling condition of childhood. It may be present at birth or develop shortly afterwards. Its most characteristic feature is the child's emotional and often physical withdrawal from society. Autistic children live in a solitary world apart. They are an enigma. Whilst most cannot read, write, speak or do any of the things we regard as essential in our society, they may not be basically sub-normal. Whilst intellectually handicapped children are often outgoing and sociable, Autistic children are the exact opposite. They look normal, often very attractive, but are completely withdrawn and their behaviour is decidedly odd.

Just as with normal children, every Autistic child is an individual but Autistic children have a severe communication problem. They are unable to relate to people and are so thoroughly isolated that they appear to the casual observer to be deaf and dumb. They never participate in games and never retaliate. If they have any close relationship at all, it is more likely to be with some inanimate object.

Unlike other children, the Autistic child cannot learn as one of a group and, at first, it is necessary to have one teacher for each child.

The new Vern-Barnett Diagnostic Teaching Centre at Forestville, believed to be the first of its type in the western world, is specifically designed for the special education and help of Autistic children. This centre will allow intensive research to be carried out in order to ascertain the origin and effects of autism.

The Centre will play a leading role in the field of remedial education for handicapped children everywhere.

There is still much to be done for all those tragically handicapped children who will still be denied help for lack of adequate facilities. When it is realised that the new Centre will cater for, at best, about 36 of the estimated 300 children in this state, you will understand that we still have a long way to go.

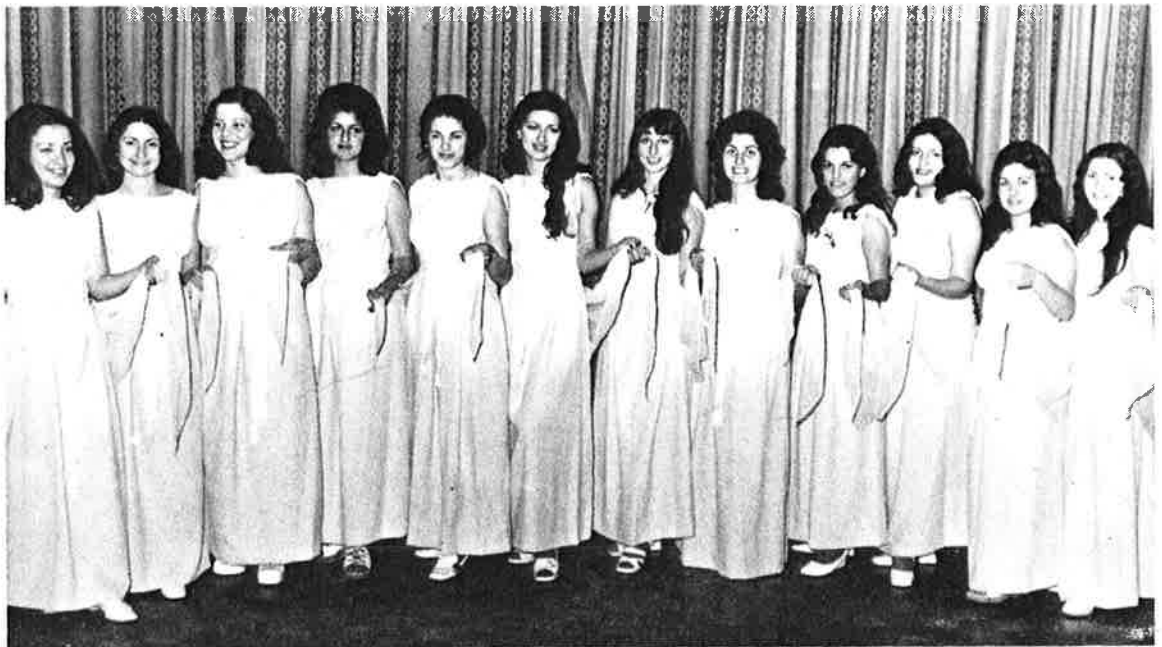

ΤΑ ΚΥΘΗΡΑ ΔΙΑ ΜΕΣΟΥ ΤΩΝ ΑΙΩΝΩΝ

Οι διάφορες αρχαιολογικές ανασκαφές που έγιναν μέχρι τώρα στα Κύθηρα, απέδειξαν πως το νησί κατά το 1700 π. Χ. ήτο ναυτική βάση της Μινωικής αυτοκρατορίας, με πρωτεύουσα τα Κύθηρα (σημερινό Παλαιόκαστρο) και λιμάνι την Σκάνθεια (σημερινό Καστρί). Μετά την παρακμή του Μινωικού κράτους τα Κύθηρα καταλαμβάνουν οι Φοίνικες, από την Φοινική της σημερινής Συρίας το 1600 π. Χ. Οι Φοίνικες, λαός εμπορικός, ανέπτυξαν περισσότερο την κατεργασία της Πορφύρας και κατεσκεύασαν το λιμάνι της Φοινικούς, στον κόλπο του σημερινού Αύλεμονα. Από το 1500 π. Χ. τα Κύθηρα περιέρχονται στην εξουσία του κράτους των Μυκηνών μέχρι το 1100 π. Χ. που έγινε η κάθοδος των Δωριέων και η εγκατάστασις των στην περιφέρεια της σημερινής Σπάρτης. Στους αρχαίους χρόνους το νησί είχε διάφορες ονομασίες όπως Πορφυρίς ή Πορφυρούσα, (άσφαλώς από την επεξεργασία της πορφύρας) Κυθηραία, Κυθουρία και άλλα. Τα νεώτερα, Τσερίγο ή Τσιρίγο, είναι ονόματα από την ένετοκρατία το δε σημερινό του όνομα Κύθηρα, προέρχεται από τον Κύθηρον, πρώτον Φοινικαίο κάτοικον του νησιού. Η πόλις Κύθηρα, με τα δυο της λιμάνια, μέσα στο πέρασμα των αιώνων εξαφανίσθηκαν από τους σεισμούς και άλλα γεωλογικά φαινόμενα με αποτέλεσμα να μεταβληθούν σε στεριά.

Οι Σπαρτιάται, βλέποντας ότι τα Κύθηρα λόγω της γεωγραφικής των θέσεως έχουν μεγάλη σημασία στα πολεμικά των σχέδια, τα καταλαμβάνουν το 600 π. Χ. Ο σοφός Χείλων είχε πη για τα Κύθηρα τα εξής: «Εἶθε νὰ μὴ ὑπῆρχον, ἀλλ' ἀφοῦ ὑπάρχουν, εἶθε νὰ καταστρέφοντο». Με τα λόγια αυτά ο Χείλων ένοούσε πως αν κάποτε τα Κύθηρα καταλάμβαναν εχθροί, θα ήτο τρομερός κίνδυνος για την Σπάρτη. Έκτοτε και μέχρι το 222 π. Χ. όπου έγινε η κατάληψις ολοκληρώ της Ελλάδος από τους Μακεδόνες, τα Κύθηρα βρίσκονται πότε υπό την κυριαρχία των Σπαρτιατών και πότε υπό των Αθηναίων.

Προτού κλείσουμε το μέρος της αρχαίας ιστορίας των Κυθίων, αξίζει να πούμε λίγα λόγια για την ζωή και τις ασχολίες των αρχαίων Κυθίων. Βασική απασχόλησις των αρχαίων Κυθίων ήταν η επεξεργασία της πορφύρας. Ασχολούντο όμως και με το εμπόριο, την ναυτιλία, την γεωργία, κτηνοτροφία, μελισσοκομία και την καλλιέργειαν κορποφόρων δένδρων.

Ο Ήρακλείδης ο Πόντιος, μαθητής του Αριστοτέλους μάς λέγει ότι οι Κυθίοι ήταν εργατικοί, αλλά φιλάργυροι και το φαγητό τους αποτελεῖτο από σῦκα και τυρί, τα όποια έτρωγαν μαζί με ψωμί. Χρησιμοποιούσαν χάλκινα νομίσματα (404 π. Χ.) και δεν ύστερούσαν στα γράμματα. Ο Ξενοδόμος (600 π. Χ.), ο Φιλόξενος (483 — 436 π. Χ.), ο Πτολεμαῖος και άλλοι, είναι από τις πνευματικές μορφές των αρχαίων Κυθίων.

Κατά τους Μακεδονικούς και Ρωμαίικους χρόνους η ιστορία δεν μάς αναφέρει τίποτα για τα Κύθηρα. Ίσως λοιπόν τα χρόνια αυτά να ήσαν έρημα και μόνον ο μαρτυρικός θάνατος της Αγίας Έλέσης το 375 μ. Χ. έγινε αφορμή να κατοικηθούν εκ νέου από Χριστιανούς της Πελοποννήσου. Από το 875 μ. Χ. — 1100 μ. Χ. η ιστορία σιωπά και πάλι για τα Κύθηρα. Είναι τα χρόνια που τα Κύθηρα ήσαν πραγματικά έρημα, παρ' ότι από το 395 μ. Χ. αποτελούσαν εξάρτημα της Βυζαντινής αυτοκρατορίας.

Σαν Βυζαντινή Έπαρχία, άρχοντες των Κυθίων από το 1110 μ. Χ. ήσαν οι Εύδαιμογιάννηδες από την Μονεμβάσια. Αυτοί, για να προστατεύσουν τους ανθρώπους που ήρχοντο από την Πελοπόννησο και Κρήτη για να κατοικήσουν στα Κύθηρα από τους πειρατές, έκτισαν το 1280 — 1310 μ. Χ. την πόλι του Αγίου Δημητρίου, την σημερινή Παληόχωρα, ενώ το 1160 μ. Χ. έχομε την εύρεσι της Εικόνας της Παναγίας της Μυρτιδιωτίσσης. Το 1204 μ. Χ. καταλαμβάνουν τα Κύθηρα οι Ένετοι για να τα παραχωρήσουν μετά από τρία χρόνια (1207 μ. Χ.) στον ευγενή Ένετο τυχεδιώκτη Μάρκο Βενιέρη, ο όποιος μόνος του πήρε τον τίτλο «Μαρκήσιος Κυθίων» διότι όπως έλεγε κατήγετο απ' εύθείας από την θεά Αφροδίτη. Το 1503 οι Ένετοι παίρνουν πίσω τα Κύθηρα από τους Βενιέρους και τα κρατούν μέχρι το 1797.

Το 1537 τα Κύθηρα γνώρισαν την μεγαλύτερη πειρατική επίδρομη από τον ληστοπειρατήν Χαϊρεντίν Βαρβαρόσσα, με αποτέλεσμα να καταστραφή η πόλις του Αγίου Δημητρίου με τους 1000 κατοίκους της και τις 72 εκκλησιές της. Το 1789 άγκυροβολεί στον Αύλεμονα με τέσσερα πλοία ο ναύαρχος Λάμπρος Κατσώνης και το 1797 ο Γάλλος, Βικέντιος Ρενώ, καταλαμβάνει τα Κύθηρα δια λογαριασμό της Γαλλικής Δημοκρατίας. Μετά από ένα χρόνο το 1798 τα Κύθηρα καταλαμβάνουν οι Ρωσο - Τούρκοι για να τα κρατήσουν μέχρι το 1807, όποτε κατελήφθησαν εκ νέου από τους Γάλλους το 1808.

Το 1809 φθάνουν στο λιμάνι του Αύλεμονα δυο Άγγλικά πολεμικά και με κανονιοβολισμούς καταστρέφουν το μικρό φρούριο (νέο Καστελλάκι) που είχαν κτίσει οι Γάλλοι, δγάζουν στρατό και επιτίθενται κατά της χώρας. Το 1814 οι Άγγλοι γίνονται κύριοι ολοκληρώ της Έπτανήσου και με την συνθήκη των Παρισίων, τα Έπτανησα άναγνωρίζονται ως «Ηνωμένα Κράτη των Ιονίων Νήσων».

Έκτοτε τα Κύθηρα ακολουθούν την τύχη της Έπτανήσου και παραμένουν υπό την Άγγλική Προστασία μέχρι την 21ην Μαΐου 1864 όποτε ύπεγράφη η συνθήκη της Ένώσεως της Έπτανήσου με την Μητέρα Ελλάδα.

Η Άγγλική κατοχή στα Κύθηρα δεν είχε μόνο δυσάρεστη πλευρά, αλλά και την ωφέλιμη, διότι κατεσκευάσθηκαν πολλά αξιόλογα κοινωφελή έργα που σώζονται μέχρι σήμερα, όπως, δρόμοι, σχολεία, δεξαμενές, η γέφυρα στο Κατούνι με τις 13 καμάρες, ο φάρος του Μουδαριού κ. ά.

Αυτή είναι, μέσα σε γενικές γραμμές η ιστορία του νησιού μας. Τα Κύθηρα σήμερα, δοκιμάζουν τον φόβο μιας νέας ερημώσεως, λόγω της μεταναστεύσεως, παρ' ότι τα μέσα του συγχρόνου πολιτισμού (δρόμοι, νερό, ηλεκτρισμός, νοσοκομείον γηροκομείον) υπάρχουν σε ίκανοποιητικό βαθμό. Σαν μοναδική λοιπόν έλπίδα σωτηρίας άπομένει πλέον η άνάπτυξις του τουρισμού στα Κύθηρα, για την άνάπτυξι του όποιου εκτός από το επίσημο κράτος, καλούμεθα και όλοι έμεις οι Κυθίοι να βοηθήσωμε με κάθε τρόπο.

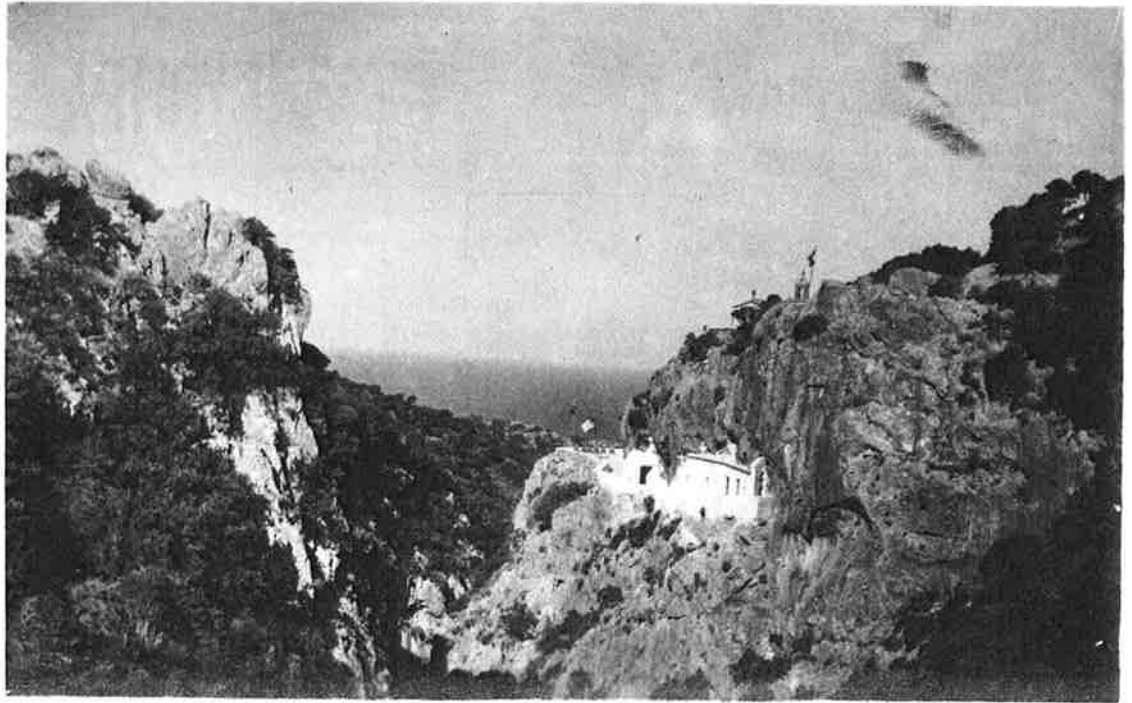
