

Kythera the Island of Love

KYTHERA

is a Greek island situated about 8 miles from Cape Malea, the southern promontory of Greece. From north to south it is nearly 20 miles long and its greatest breadth. In the church of St. Kosmas are preserved archaic Doric columns of the famous Temple of Venus. It was believed that it was upon this island that Venus emerged from the sea. Hense its popular name — the island of love. The island is rocky, but streams abound, and there are fertile districts. Two great caves, with stalactites, are among its natural peculiarities. Much land is pasture but wine, corn, olive oil and highly prized honey are produced for export.

In mediaeval and modern history Kythera ranks as one of the Ionian Islands and shares their most colorful hi-





HISTORY OF THE KYTHERIAN BROTHERHOOD OF AUSTRALIA

It has been fifty glorious years since our forefathers saw the need to unite the Kytherian Community into the bonds of an Association, which had as objectives, good fellowship, social and cultural activities among a group of people that have a lot in common, and helping the underpriviledged by contributing to various charities, both in Australia and Greece.

Early in 1921, two prominent Kytherians in Sydney brought the idea forward. It was almost 12 months before the idea finally became reality, and on the 14th of May 1922 the inaugural meeting of the Kytherian Brotherhood took place at the "Marathon" cafe situated then at No. 72 Oxford St., Darlinghurst.

That night, the founders the late Cosmas Cassimatis and Theodore Crithary, called for a constitution to be drawn up and a date to be set for a general meeting and elections of a managing committee.

The elections were held on the 20th of August 1922, and the Foundation committee was elected to serve for the following 2 years. They were:

COSMAS CASSIMATIS — President
PETER MINOUKOS — Vice President
BILL FEROS — Secretary
NICK MARCELLOS — Treasurer.

The activity and progress of the Kytherian Brotherhood has been outstanding. The far-sighted founders of the Brotherhood, could not have possibly foreseen that the little social group they started would have grown into one of the largest Associations. Over the years, donations of many thousands of dollars have been given to various charitable institutions and associations. The activities have reached tar across the oceans to the island of Kythera, where the Brotherhood has made numerous contributions to various public works, hospitals, schools and general relief to the underprivileged.

During the Second World War, the Kytherian Brotherhood was instrumental in the organisation of a war-relief fund for Greece and a large sum of money was eventually remitted to Greece.

The Kytherians of today, enjoy a very high esteem both in the Greek and Australian communities. Because of the very early migration of Kytherians to Australia, the community consists mainly of Australian born people, well established in the business and professional world.

Reflecting back over the years, it becomes very clear that the Kytherians in Australia have been among the most progressive migrants, assimilating well into the Australian community, without neglecting to carry on some of the fine traditions of the old country.

Archivides Kalokerinos (known as "Archie")

Born 28-9-27 at Glen Innes, N.S.W.

Father, Nicholas Kalokerinos, deceased, from Alexandratis (?spelling) Kythera, Mother Mary Kalokerinos, living in Rose Bay from Potamos, Kythera.

Graduated M.B., B.S. University Sydney 1951. Spend 6 years in England after graduation then commenced practice at Collarenebri, N.S.W., in 1957. Living at Collarenebri was another Kytherian family (Emmanuel Petrohelos) which happened to be actual next door neighbours to my father in Greece. Emmanuel became a friend - father relation and influenced, considerably, what was to happen.

The problem at Collarenebri was a shockingly high infant death rate. Most of the deaths occured amongst the Aboriginal people but there were many amongst the white families. Attempts to solve the problem over an 8year period failed and at that stage, dissappointment and dissillusioned, I forsake medicine for a new life at Coober Pedy, South Australia, as an opal miner.

Strangely, at the time, Australian opal poorly underestood. I undertook an intensive study the amounted to extreme facination and resulted in the taking of 60.000 colour slides of opal specimens and the publication of two books. It so happened that Coober Pedy was the home of many tribal Aborigines. Close contact with these people led me to further thinking about their health problems and in

1967 I returned to medical practice at Collarenebri with the intention of trying out some new ideas

Results of these ideas exceeded all hopes. From that date on not a single infant, black or white, died at Collarenebri from illness - a dramatic event, reasons for which have been hotly debated. Fundamentally, the study involved the use of vitamin C. The details are quite complex and have led to the use of this vitamin in a wide range of medical problems.

Cot deaths (or sudden, unexpected infant deaths) have been the main part of my work over the past 12 years. At the same time I have become deply involved in Aboriginal affairs and, until recently, have been more than a little dissapointment at the lack of interest demonstrated by Greek - Ausralians in this

Since 1975 I have been employed as medical officer at the Aboriginal Medical Service based at Redfern. But the work covers almost the whole of Australia. Apart from direct medical care welfare work in ggols, children's homes and institutions has become important. There is special attention to alcoholism and drug related problems. Writing, lecturing to home and abroard takes up much of my time. Finally, attempts are being made to relate Aboriginal health problems with those of the white community and many countries over-

SKANDIA is the name

of an ancient leading town in Kythera, the history of which goes back to the dawn of Greek civilisation. According to historians Thucydides and Pausanias, Skandia was situated on the present-day Kastri Promontory where, in 1932, Miss Benton of the British Archaeological School of Athens, discovered remnants of a Minoan housing settlement.

Two miles inland, on the mount Paleokastro, archaeologists had observed ruins of the Greek period, capitals of Doric columns among them, which were later used in the building of Sain! Cosma's church. These column heads, dating back to the 6th century B.C., belonged probably to the more ancient temple of Aphrodite, whose worship, according to Herodotus, was introduced to the island by the Phoenicians.

Upon this mountain was the Upper Town of Ancient Kythera, which was destroyed by the Athenian General Nikias in 424 B.C., the island then being a Spartan colony.

Since 1963, successive excavations, conducted by a mixed mission of the Museum of Pennsylvania University and the British School of Athens, have unearthed much evidence strongly pointing to the belief that ancient Kythera had been a Cretan colony and the influence of Cretan civilisation at the time Crete reigned supreme as the leading naval power in the Mediterranean.

There have been discovered houses with small foundations and narrow doors resembling those of the later Minoan period (1400 B.C.), vases similar to those used in Crete about 2000 B.C. and other many-coloured vessels typical of that Cretan period and art, and strongly suggesting that it was mainly commerce that had induced the Cretans to settle on Kythera.

At that period Skandia and the town of Kythera were enjoying great economic prosperity, due mostly to profitable fishing of porphyry shells in the gulf of present-day Avlemon, and to the fact that the port of Skandia was a centre of commercial transportation between eastern and western Meditarranean.

This, of course, is only a synoptical history of ancient Skandia, and generally Kythera, the island which, according to archaelogical, must have been the first Minoa colony beyond Cretan shores.


