Relaunch of rare migration handbook

Good Greek advice

WITH migrants and migration constantly in the news, George Vardas of Oatley said the advice aimed at Greek migrants 93 years ago still held true today.

Mr Vardas, the son of Greek migrants, said those early arrivals, many of whom came from the island of Kythera, were advised to practise virtues such as hard work, honesty and diligence. and photographs of Greek
